Notice of 30 day Comment Period: January 30, 2015 – March 1, 2015
Re: Reprogram of Prior Year CDBG funds

In conformance with HUD regulations regarding CDBG funds, residents, local agencies and community groups will have the opportunity to comment on the reallocation of \$133,330 from 2014 CDBG balances.

The Halcyon Park area experiences flooding on a regular basis due to an outdated, undersized and poorly designed drainage system.

The proposal for the Halcyon Park Drainage Project consists of the removal or relocation of various drainage and utility structures and installation of new structures beneath Brookdale Avenue, beginning at an existing culvert in the vicinity of 71 Brookdale Avenue and extending northward to the intersection of Brookdale Avenue and Lorenz Avenue.

The Halcyon Park Drainage Project is funded through various reimbursement grants totaling almost \$2 million. The remaining funding is comprised of a combination of general obligation bonds, CHIPS allocations, CDBG and utility company reimbursement.

The construction component of the project is expected to begin following the required comment period, hearing notice and HUD's environmental review requirements.

This budget revision will amend the funding priorities of the City's 2014 Action Plan and the 2013-2017 Consolidated Plans.

A Public Comment period will extend from **January 30, 2015 through March 1, 2015**. The Public Hearing will be held on **February 10, 2015** in the City Council Chambers at 7:30 P.M at 515 North Ave. New Rochelle, N.Y. 10801.

Written comments concerning the proposed re-program of CDBG funds will be accepted up through March 1, 2015.
