2012 REFUSE COLLECTION SCHEDULE

REFERENCE MATERIAL

DO NOT DISCARD

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

OCTOBER 16TH - DECEMBER 25TH (WEATHER PERMITTING)

- Leaves must be placed in 30-40 gallon biodegradable paper bags or loose in containers, none of which weigh more than 75 lbs. **OR** raked to the curb and placed in long wind rows.
- Leaves should **NOT** be placed in the street where they would impede the flow of traffic or in front of fire hydrants or catch basins.
- Leaves placed in plastic bags or leaf piles that are mixed with other debris (twigs, branches, garbage) **WILL NOT BE REMOVED.**
- The department provides Citywide pick up of bagged leaves on the six Saturdays listed on the collection schedule and denoted with a leaf symbol. Bagged leaves must be placed at the curb on those Saturdays by 7AM. No appointment is necessary.

2012 BAGGED LEAF PICKUP SATURDAYS

November 3, 10, 17 • December 1, 8, 15

STREET SWEEPING

- Street Sweeping is discontinued for Alternate Side and residential areas during the leaf collection season. Parking restrictions however remain in effect.
- Alternate side of the street restrictions are suspended for the period of January 1 - March 31 on those streets listed in the City Code.

ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING REGULATIONS CLEAR THE STREETS FOR SWEEPING. PLEASE OBSERVE THE PARKING RULES IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD.

SNOW EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

- Property owners or occupants must keep sidewalks and fire hydrants clear, clean from snow, ice and dirt.
- Snow and ice must be removed from sidewalk abutting their property and fire hydrants before 12 noon of the day after any snowfall which occurs during the night.

IN THE EVENT OF A SNOW EMERGENCY, ALL VEHICLES PARKED ON A SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTE MUST BE REMOVED.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

FIRST WEEK IN APRIL - SECOND FRIDAY IN OCTOBER

- Yard waste must be placed at the curb by 7AM (6AM during summer months) on the scheduled collection days **OR** after 10PM on the evening prior to collection.
- Yard waste shall be placed in open containers or biodegradable bags weighing no more than 75 pounds.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Tied brush and branches no longer than 4 feet in length with a diameter no more than 3 inches. Bundles may not be tied with tape or wire.
- Grass clippings, twigs, leaves, and other loose yard waste.

DO NOT INCLUDE logs, stumps, stones, dirt, fruit, seaweed, clumps of grass, treated wood chips, root balls, acorns, and other large debris. These items **WILL NOT BE COLLECTED** and must be disposed of by the homeowner.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION DAYS

Tuesday - North side of the Metro North Railroad/New Haven Line to Eastchester Road, Beechmont Drive, and Barnard Road

Wednesday - North side of Quaker Ridge Road to the Scarsdale Border

Thursday - Eastchester Road, Beechmont Drive, and Barnard Road, both sides and north to the South side of Quaker Ridge Road

Friday - South of the Metro North Railroad

WHEN A HOLIDAY OCCURS ON ANY OF THE COLLECTION DAYS **MONDAY** IS THE ALTERNATE COLLECTION DAY

All materials must be placed at the curbside by 7AM For the summer months only (Memorial Day through Labor Day / May 28 - September 3, 2012), all material must be placed at the curbside by 6AM

GARBAGE & TRASH

Collection Schedule:

NORTH END: **Monday & Thursday**

SOUTH END: **Tuesday & Friday**

- Garbage must be placed in garbage cans no larger than 32 gallons and weigh no more than 75 pounds
- Heavy duty plastic bags may be used but weigh no more than 75 pounds
- Brown leaf/yard waste bags are NOT ACCEPTABLE for garbage

RECYCLABLES

Collection Schedule: **Alternating Wednesdays**


Commingled recyclables will be collected one week and newspapers, cardboard, junk mail the following week.

COMMINGLED

Only those once used for food, beverage or soap products

METAL: Cans; clean foil food trays and tin

GLASS: Jars, bottles, brown or clear glass

PLASTIC: Containers PET coded 1 - 7 

- Rinse recyclables clean, remove caps; labels can remain. Place caps loose for collection.
- Commingled Recycling must be placed in garbage cans no larger than 32 gallons weighing no more than 75 pounds.
PAPER AND PLASTIC BAGS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.

PAPER & CARDBOARD

Newspapers, glossy inserts; colored, glossy periodicals, merchandise catalogs, magazines, telephone books, junk mail

- Do NOT tie papers or magazines
- **CARDBOARD:** Corrugated or gray such as cereal and pizza boxes can be flattened and tied into bundles OR mixed with Paper Collection
- Paper/Cardboard Recycling must be placed in garbage cans no larger than 32 gallons or paper grocery bags.
PLASTIC BAGS, BROWN LEAF/YARD WASTE BAGS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.

DURING HOLIDAY WEEKS TRASH WILL BE PICKED UP ON 1st COLLECTION • TRASH & RECYCLING WILL BE PICKED UP ON 2nd COLLECTION

TELEVISIONS AND COMPUTERS

Collection Schedule: **By Appointment ONLY**

2nd Saturday - NORTH END only

3rd Saturday - SOUTH, EAST or WEST END only

Call 914-235-5830 prior to Thursday at 3PM of your collection week to schedule a pickup. Place curbside by 7AM (6AM during summer months).

APPLIANCES & HEAVY METAL ITEMS

Collection Schedule: **WEDNESDAYS By Appointment ONLY**

Call the Bureau of Sanitation prior to 12 noon on the Tuesday before collection at 914-235-3593. Place items curbside by 7AM (6AM during summer months).

Refrigerators, freezers or air conditioners require a sticker for Freon removal* prior to pickup

- Freon removal stickers are sold at the City Clerk's office at City Hall (phone 914-654-2159) for \$25
- After obtaining the sticker call 914-235-3593 to schedule an appointment for pickup
- Place sticker on the refrigerator, freezer or air conditioner and place items curbside by 7AM (6AM during summer months). **There will be no appliance pickup during holiday weeks.**

*As an alternative, residents may have their own licensed contractor remove the freon gas and place their company sticker on the appliance.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

THESE MUST NOT be disposed of in Garbage or Recycling:

- **Containers** that were used for hazardous material, aluminum siding, standard paint cans, scrap metal, wire, pipes, tubing, motors, sheet metal, soiled aluminum foil and automobile parts
- **Radiological Medical Residual** - Return them to the hospital or health care facility where you or your pet received treatment. For further information call Westchester County's Hotline 914-813-5425
- **Hazardous Materials** of all types including ALL fluorescent bulbs. Violators are subject to fines and/or prosecution.
- **Clothing Hangers** - return to cleaners
- **Cell phone/parts** - recycle at City locations


Hazardous materials can only be disposed of at one of the locations for Westchester County's Chemical Cleanup Days.
