With the end of summer, there are many new things happening in New Rochelle's business community. Here are some of the highlights...

Circuit provides free rides in New Rochelle

On Aug. 22, the City launched "CircuitNR," a complimentary, on-demand electric shuttle service that transports riders along several routes in the downtown. The coverage area includes Main & Huguenot, Memorial Highway, and North Avenue up to Fifth Ave.

CircuitNR is available Monday through Thursday from 7AM-7PM, Friday from 7AM-10PM, Saturday between noon-10PM and Sunday from noon- 7PM.

How does it work? You can request an on-demand ride anywhere in the shuttle coverage area by using the "Ride Circuit" App to alert a fleet driver to come pick you up. Alternatively, rides can be hailed by simply waving down the nearest CircuitNR driver if the vehicle has vacant seats.

Please let your customers know about this new option for travel in the downtown. I have postcards available for you to share - let me know if you want some.

New York State Sexual Harassment Prevention Training

As of October 9, 2018, all New York State (NYS) employers are required to provide sexual harassment prevention training on an annual basis. Each employer has one year to comply with this new law, and he or she must facilitate the sexual harassment prevention training session by October 9th of each year. The New Rochelle Chamber of Commerce has partnered with New Haven Consulting Group, Inc., who has developed an online training that meets the State's detailed requirements.

PSH-NYS, conducted as a traditional classroom or as an online workshop, addresses both the legal and behavioral aspects of sexual harassment to ensure an inclusive, highly productive work environment.
